We proactively work to identify and address the underlying factors for women presenting with multiple, complex needs and position our services to achieve the very best for women we support.

Volunteer Food Bank Delivery Driver (3.5 hrs per week on a Wednesday)

The weekly food bank at BWC provides a crucial service to women and families during times of financial crisis or hardship. To ensure that we can open and run the food bank every week we rely on a team of dedicated volunteers. We are looking for a delivery driver to take food parcels from our food bank to those women across Brighton and Hove who are unable to attend in person due to their own social or medical circumstances.

Teamwork is vital to the success and professional standard of the centre and all volunteers are encouraged to take an active part in regular meetings and contribute to the general development of the centre. This may also include taking responsibility for specific areas of work.

Volunteer drivers must have access to their own taxed and insured vehicle plus a full UK driving licence. BWC will remunerate the successful candidate for mileage accrued during volunteering hours on a monthly basis.

Strict adherence to confidentiality, particularly in respect of personal details and background of workers and clients is required of all workers.
